### The All India Student Young Professionals Women in Engineering Life Members Congress (AISYWLC) 2025

The All India Student Young Professionals Women in Engineering Life Members Congress (AISYWLC) 2025, the flagship national congress of the IEEE India Council, was successfully conducted on 31st October, 1st November, and 2nd November 2025.

This edition holds special significance, as for the first time in eleven years, the congress was hosted by the IEEE Gujarat Section. AISYWLC 2025 brought together delegates from across India, representing diverse IEEE communities, technical domains, and leadership roles.

The three-day congress was organized across two host institutions in Ahmedabad, Gujarat:

- Day 1 & Day 2: Adani University, Gujarat
- Day 3: Nirma University, Gujarat

AISYWLC 2025 featured a structured blend of keynote addresses, domain-specific tracks, professional development sessions, panel discussions, workshops, and networking forums.




Overall, Day 0 successfully combined event logistics, cultural immersion, and social interaction, creating a welcoming environment for participants.

This informal session encouraged idea-sharing, early conversations about leadership, technology, and innovation, and relationship-building among delegates from diverse backgrounds.


Many participants took this opportunity to meet mentors, discuss professional experiences, and forge connections that would support collaboration throughout the congress.

Delegates engaged with fellow participants, exchanged ideas, and captured memorable moments, strengthening bonds across sections, domains, and regions.


